

JUNIOR CLOTHING/SEWING-CONSUMER SAVVY

Department 260

RULES

1. No more than five entries per exhibitor per class not including Style Revue entries. One exhibit per entry number. Each entry must be a different type of article.
2. Articles made for Style Revue cannot be exhibited in Classes A-E.
3. All articles must have been made since the last Fair.
4. Articles may be worn prior to exhibit, but must be clean and ironed or pressed.
5. All entries shall have the entry tags pinned (with safety pin) onto upper left area of the garment or article (as you look at it) before coming to the judging.
6. Hangers must accompany all hanging type garments/articles.
7. Garments made as school projects may not be shown.
8. Each exhibit must have evidence of different construction skills and made from a different pattern or fabric.
9. Explanations must accompany each exhibit in Class E Consumer Savvy, and be fastened securely. Include the age of the child for whom the exhibit was made and why it is appropriate for this child. Entries without explanations will be dropped one place.

Examples of Skills: darts, facings, interfacings, zippers, collars, cuffs, hems, buttons, buttonholes, pleats, topstitching, gathers, understitching, matching plaids, stripes and designs. Restyle or recycle, altering patterns or tailoring. For advanced projects, each single garment exhibited must contain at least two different advanced techniques.

STYLE REVUE/CONSUMER SAVVY RULES

1. Every exhibitor in the Clothing/Consumer Savvy project is encouraged to participate in the Style Revue judging which will be judged before the Fair.
2. Entries are limited to ONE GARMENT PER MEMBER in each of the Clothing and Consumer Savvy projects if enrolled in both projects, plus entries for another individual in the intermediate and advanced categories.
3. Garments made in school are not eligible for entering.
4. Garments must be made for and worn by the exhibitor or another person.
5. Style Revue and Consumer Savvy entries must be entered on your Fair Entry Form.

ADVANCED (5 or more years)

19. Two-piece outfit (not sportswear)
20. Two-piece sportswear outfit (not a dress)
21. Dress for school or general wear
22. Formal dress
23. Suit or coat
24. Any 3- or more piece outfit, for member, not listed above
25. Outfit consisting of at least one article constructed by member (not listed above), rest of outfit may be purchased clothing.
26. Garment for a child (age 7 & younger). Must be modeled by child that apparel is constructed for.
27. Garment for a youth (age 8-17 years) Must be modeled by youth that apparel is constructed for.
28. Garment for adult (age 18 & older). Must be modeled by adult that apparel is constructed for.
29. Any made over or re-created garment, bring photo of original garment before make over.

1. No more than five entries per exhibitor. One exhibit per entry number.
2. Entry tags shall be securely fastened to the article.
3. All entries must have been made since last Fair.
4. Entries with more than one part must be securely fastened together.
5. Class E entries require a minimum 1 ounce hand-spun skein.
