RULES FOR CLASSES D-F

1. Limited to three entries per exhibitor.
2. If wall hanging, entry must have a hanging sleeve, sewn at the top of the entry and is 4" wide. Maximum size = 200" perimeter. entry must have 4" wide hanging sleeve sewn along the top.
3. The other (entry 3, 6, & 9) category is limited to tablecloths, table runners, pillows, treeskirts, restored quilts, etc. Cannot be another wallhanging or new quilt.
