

OPEN CLASS GOAT DEPARTMENT

RULES

1. **See Open Class General Rules.**
2. All animals must meet state health regulations listed under Wisconsin County, District and State Fairs Animal Health Rules and Regulations.
3. All animals shall be in their designated pen by 6:00 p.m. Wednesday. Late Check-Ins will forfeit any premiums.
4. Campers must register with the Fair Office.
5. ADGA and ABGA standards will be adhered to.
6. No bedding is furnished by the Fair.
7. Junior exhibitors must exhibit animals other than those shown in Junior Show Classes.
8. Goats must have identification:
 - a Dairy - legible tattoo consistent with ADGA registration certificate (copy)
 - b Meat - legible tattoo with matching ABGA or other Breed registration certificate (copy), or scrapies tag and copy of scrapies letter.
9. Only Mini-exhibitors who have shown in a Breed class may participate in a Performance Class.
10. ALL animals shown in group classes must have shown in their regular single class.
11. Animals with natural horns (not disbudded or dehorned) shall not be shown except Angora, Boer and Pygmy goats based on the Breed Standard of the Goat. Goat Superintendent has final decision.
12. Milk out will be determined by the judge.
13. Performance Classes: (open to both Dairy and Meat Goat Youth Exhibitors and Mini-exhibitors showing in Open Class) Guidelines for each may be found in the PERFORMANCE CLASS DIVISION. The Divisions are: Class, Costume Class and Obstacle Course Class. Goat Cart Class is ONLY available to Youth Exhibitors entered in the Junior Goat Department.
14. When not in pen, every goat must wear a collar.
15. Breed categories exhibiting insufficient entries may be combined.
16. Bucks are prohibited
17. Entry fee is \$5.00 per animal (non-refundable).
18. Judge's decision is final once awards are presented to the exhibitor.

1. Junior Doe Kid - under 3 mos. (March 1st – July 1st of current year) (4 mos.)
2. Intermediate Doe Kid – Feb. (5 mos.)
3. Senior Doe Kid – Jan. (6 mos.)
4. Junior Yearling Doe – born during the period of July 1st to December 31st of previous (last) year
5. Senior Yearling Doe – is a dry doe born before May 31st or earlier of previous (last) year and less than 24 months of age

6. Jr. Get of Sire: Three does of 1 breed, none in milk, from the same sire
7. Junior Produce of Dam: Two progeny of one dam; neither in milk
8. Yearling Milker / Doe, under 2 in milk
9. Junior Milker / Doe, 2 years and under 3
10. Senior Milker / Doe, 3 years and under 4
11. Mature Milker / Doe, 4 years and under 5

12. Aged Milker / Doe, 5 years and under 6
13. Senior Aged Milker / Doe 6 years and over

14. Sr Produce of Dam: Two progeny of one dam; both must be in milk.
15. Dam and Daughter: of one breed; both must be in milk
16. Sr. Get of Sire: Three does of one breed, all in milk, from the same sire.
17. Breeder’s Trio: All owned by the exhibitor - Three does of one breed, all in milk.
18. Dairy Herd: All owned by the exhibitor - four does of one breed, all in milk.
19. Exhibitor’s Herd: All owned by the exhibitor - Three does: One - 2 yrs old or over, One - yearling and under 2 years, One - under one year.

The Best Junior Doe in Show will be selected from the breed show champions at the end of the last Junior Doe division.

Best Junior Doe in Show - AWARD

The Best Senior Doe in Show will be selected from the breed show champions at the end of the last Senior Doe division.

PERFORMANCE CLASSES: (ONLY Mini-exhibitor - open to both Dairy and Meat Goat Animals) NO PREMIUMS

DIVISION: OBSTACLE COURSE

1. Mini exhibitors showing in Open Class may participate in the obstacle course. They must use an animal they worked with and showed in Open Class. This will not be judged or timed.

NO awards besides participation will be given.

DIVISION: COSTUME CLASS

1. Mini exhibitors showing in Open Class may participate in the costume class. They may use an animal they worked with and showed in Open Class, depending on the age of the mini. This will be judged for creativity.

Awards for participation only given.

- 10. **FULLBLOOD GET OF SIRE:** Three Fullblood or Purebred offspring of the same buck (sire). Any age. Do not have to be owned by the same person.
- 11. **PERCENTAGE GET OF SIRE:** Three Percentage does, any age that are by the same buck (sire). Do not have to be owned by the same person
- 12. **FULLBLOOD PRODUCE OF DAM:** Two offspring out of the same doe. Do not have to be owned by the same person.
- 13. **PERCENTAGE PRODUCE OF DAM:** Two offspring out of the same doe. To be eligible, the dam must be registered in a breed Herd book. Do not have to be owned by the same person.
- 14. **FULLBLOOD BREEDER'S HERD:** The exhibitor of the herd must be the breeder of record. Co-owner of the dam of the included goat(s) at the time of conception:
 - a. Two Fullblood or Purebred does less than 12 months,
 - b. Two Fullblood or Purebred does 12 months or greater.
 - c. A whether under 1 year of age.
- 15. **PERCENTAGE DOE BREEDER'S HERD:** The exhibitor of the herd must be the breeder of record.
 - a. Two Fullblood or Purebred does less than 12 months,
 - b. Two Fullblood or Purebred does 12 months or greater.
 - c. A whether under 1 year of age.
- 16. **BEST PAIR KIDS:** Two animals shown in the 0–12-month classes of the respective division.
Classes are:
 - A. Best Pair of Fullblood Doe Kids,
 - B. Best Pair of Percentage Doe Kids
- 17. **BEST PAIR ONE YEAR AND OLDER:** Two animals shown in the yearling and/or senior classes of the respective divisions.
Classes are:
 - A. Best Pair of Senior Fullblood Does,
 - B. Best Pair of Senior Percentage Does

18. PERFORMANCE CLASSES: (ONLY Mini-exhibitor - open to both Dairy and Meat Goat Animals) NO PREMIUMS

A. DIVISION: OBSTACLE COURSE:

- 1. Mini exhibitors showing in Open Class may participate in the obstacle course. They must use an animal they worked with and showed in Open Class. This will not be judged or timed.

NO awards besides participation will be given.

B. DIVISION: COSTUME CLASS

- 1. Mini exhibitors showing in Open Class may participate in the costume class. They may use an animal they worked with and showed in Open Class, depending on the age of the mini. This will be judged for creativity.
