RULES FOR DEMONSTRATIONS & PUBLIC SPEAKING

1. **Please read Junior Class rules first.**
2. POSTERS: All posters must be 14"x22" in size and on poster board. Those not adhering to these two rules will be dropped one placing. Posters will be hole punched by superintendents for hanging/displaying.

RULES FOR LIVE PERFORMANCE ON FAMILY FUN STAGE

1. Please see Junior Class rules first.
2. All exhibitors must report in at least ten minutes before the scheduled stage time.
3. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing all supporting materials with them, including laptop, if necessary.
4. **Live Performance participants must submit their entry in the Fair Entry Software to receive premiums.** In the case of a team demonstration, only one member of the team should enter on the entry blank. Be sure to list the second member of the team. Premiums are sent to one member and is to be divided equally.
5. Demonstration entrants will present a demo on their given topic using the guidelines for length below: an Individual (1 person): 3-5 minutes b Team (2+ people): 4-7 minutes.
6. Public Speaking entrants will present a speech on their given topic using the guidelines for length below:
 - A. Junior (8 to 11 years old): 1 to 3 minutes)
 - B. Intermediate (12 to 14 years old: 2 to 4 minutes)
 - C. Senior (15+ years old: 3 to 5 minutes)
7. Division: Live Performance may be performed multiple times during Fair (Thursday – Sunday). Performance time must be scheduled with Family Fun Stage Superintendent when sign-ups are announced. No additional premiums or ribbons will be awarded after the initial performance.
8. Mini Members may participate but must register in Division 217.
9. Live Performances should introduce title, author, and when written, if possible.
